

VILLAGE CAMPS POLICIES

The following are Village Camps Policies. Please read through them with your child(ren) and be sure that all information is understood. If you have any questions pertaining to our policies or the Outdoor Education Programme, please do not hesitate to contact the party leader. We want to make this trip a fun and safe experience that your child will never forget.

While the staff will make every effort to ensure that a child takes the maximum advantage of the activities we provide, it is the school's and Village Camps' policy not to force the student to do any of the activities for the following reasons:

1. The student is physically unfit.
2. The weather conditions may make the activities dangerous or unenjoyable.
3. After repeated attempts to persuade the student, he/she still refuses to participate.

Village Camps reserves the right, together with the party leader, to dismiss or send home any child that violates any of the camp policies. In such cases, no refund of the fees can be made. If a child is sent home, for any reason, it will be at the parent's expense.

Village camps shall have full authority, in conjunction with the party leader, to take whatever action it deems necessary to safeguard the health and well being of a child. Such authority will include the right of Village Camps to secure medical treatment for the child at the parent or guardian's expense.

Students will be held responsible for any damage caused, whether wilful or not, to facilities, equipment or anything else belonging to or leased by Village Camps. Repairs will be made and the bill will be sent to the school for action. On the case where the damage is in a shared room and the person responsible cannot be determined, the bill will be split between all children sharing the room.

Parents or guardians accept full financial responsibility for rental or purchase of any equipment deemed essential for a child to enjoy his/her holiday due to their own equipment being unfit, unsafe or missing, (including waterproof clothing & footwear).

Village Camps accepts no responsibility in the unlikely event that the roads or public transport leading to the sites are closed for whatever reason. In this case, Village Camps will make every effort to ensure that the group have accommodation either in the resort (if group is unable to leave), or in other places (if the group is unable to reach the site). It is understood that any extra expenses that may be incurred are the entire responsibility of the group.

Possession and/or the use of alcohol, drugs, weapons and/or fireworks are forbidden.
